Collaboration Center Foundation was established in February 2019, to serve and support the lives of families, caregivers and individuals living with Intellectual, Developmental, Physical and Learning Disabilities of all ages, by providing the largest disability resource and support network in Nevada

Disability Prevalence and Challenge

- Autism affects 1 in 36 children (Just updated by CDC from 1 in 45)
- Down Syndrome affects 1 in every 700 births
- Cerebral Palsy affects 1 in every 323 births
- There are approximately 850 children in Southern Nevada with some type of hearing loss, and over 15,800 children and youth in Nevada are visually impaired or legally blind.
- Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Disorder is on the rise and the cost of every untreated child is \$2 million over a lifetime
- There are over 9,000 students (3-19) in Washoe County Special Education Programs living with one or more disabilities.
- There are over 40,000 students (3-19) in Clark County Special Education Programs living with one or more disabilities.
- There are over 4,000 children and youth on services waitlists and there is lack of coordinated care.

Mission/Vision

Collaboration Center is a safe 5-acre campus community for inclusion and a disability resource network, focused upon family and peer engagement, social interaction, recreation, therapy, and education to enhance the lives of those touched by Intellectual, Developmental, Physical, and Learning Disabilities (ID/DD/PD/LD) of ALL ages.

Our vision is to create the largest collaborative disability network and support model statewide and nationally to help every individual and family member in need of disability related services get connected to the best resources for the greatest outcomes, while creating a safe campus community that meets families where they are and promotes health and wellness, physical and mental health, and strong supportive relationships. We achieve this by housing other non-profits, providers, medical and mental health professionals and government agencies while coordinating client care through our Pathways Care Coordination and Family Inclusion program.
